Incident	Functionality Impacted	Description
<b>INTRX-2860</b>	Cancellation Requests	<p><b>Issue:</b> A provider can attempt to cancel a prescription that was previously sent to a pharmacy by sending a cancel request through the cancel_rxbundle API. To send a cancellation request, a reason why this prescription is attempting to be cancelled must be included.</p> <p>A new version of these cancelation reasons were made available, however, the cancel_rxbundle API was not able to accept these new codes in the 'CancelReason' field due to the new coding set value where they originated from.</p> <p><b>Resolution:</b> Partners may now send cancel request codes from newer and previous coding set reasons for the cancel_rxbundle 'CancelReason' field.</p>
